### VEHICLE PRE-REGISTRATION DEADLINE DRAWING NEAR

**SAN BERNARDINO, CALIF. (July 25, 2008)**– The pre-registration deadline is drawing near for the 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Stater Bros. Route 66 Rendezvous<sup>®</sup>, being held September 18 – 21, 2008, California's largest cruisin' classic car show that transforms the 35-blocks of historical downtown San Bernardino into an automotive paradise with 1,900 hot rods, classics and custom cars cruising. The deadline to pre-register a vehicle made from model year 1900 through 1973 along with any year Corvette, Viper or Prowler is **August 1, 2008**.

“For those that pre-register, not only do you save \$10.00 on registration fees, but there are still some choice spaces to be assigned if we receive the paperwork by August 1,” states Shelly McNaul, director of operations for the Route 66 Rendezvous, which is produced by The San Bernardino Convention & Visitors Bureau. “We began assigning spaces in 2006, and everyone agrees it takes the stress out of trying to secure your own space at the event so you can focus on having a good time.” Completed registration forms must be postmarked by August 1, 2008 or hand-delivered by that date to the Route 66 Rendezvous office located at 415 West 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, San Bernardino.

Registration forms are available online at [www.route-66.org](http://www.route-66.org) and at “Our Town” located within The California Welcome Center – San Bernardino, 1955 Hunts Lane (off Hospitality Lane). Pre-registration fees are \$70.00, which includes four-day reserved parking with assigned number, participant credentials, official event T-shirt, commemorative license plate and dash plaque. After August 1, new registrants will be on-site beginning Friday September 19, at the cost of \$80.00.

This event is free to the public who will enjoy the classic cars, music and entertainment, sponsor displays, legendary guests, contests and vendors.
